At a Glance

- Founded in 1908, The Osborn is the oldest private, continuum of care community in the area.
- The Osborn, Osborn Home Care, and The Osborn Foundation are 501(c)(3) non-profit organizations.
- The Osborn Foundation supports over \$3 million per year in charity care for residents who outlive their resources.
- The Osborn's campus is located on 56 acres on the highest point in Rye.
- The main Osborn building was designed by Bruce Price, an American architect well-known for the Chateau Frontenac in Quebec City and private residences in Tuxedo Park, New York.
- The Osborn is home to 435 residents across different levels of care.
- The Osborn consists of 188 Independent Living and 97 Assisted Living residences; 13 Memory Care, 50 Long Term Skilled Nursing, and 35 Short Term Rehab beds.
- There are over 900 employees between The Osborn and Osborn Home Care.
- The Osborn is accredited by CARF, the gold standard for retirement communities.
- The Osborn maintains an A- Fitch rating for financial stability.
- The Osborn's Pavilion skilled nursing and short-stay rehabilitation center was named one of New York State's top-performing nursing homes by *U.S. News & World Report*.
